3. Certificates for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each class (Unless otherwise stated)
4. Each exhibit may only be entered in one section
5. Persons applying for reduced member rate for entries must hold membership for a period of 3 months prior to the show. Membership cards must be shown at time of entries.
6. For Entry Fees & Pavilion Lodgement times please refer to the individual Section you are entering. Please use a separate entry form for each section being entered
7. Entries must be exhibited according to this schedule or entries will be disqualified
8. The decision of the judge will be final on all questions of merit
9. The judges are at liberty to withhold any prize
10. Champion Ribbon will be awarded at the discretion of the judges
11. Place cards will not be removed by exhibitors
12. Exhibitors may affix on any entry card with the sale price of the item provided that no such card is affixed until after prize cards are awarded and placed on exhibits by stewards

### Apple and Cinnamon cake recipe

#### Ingredients

- 2 cups self-raising flour
- 1 ½ teaspoons cinnamon
- Pinch salt
- 1 ½ cups brown sugar
- 1/3 cup raisins
- 2 eggs beaten
- 125gm butter melted
- ¾ cup milk
- 250g apples peeled and cored and chopped

#### Method

Sift flour, cinnamon and salt into large bowl, stir in sugar and raisins. Mix in the melted butter, eggs, milk and apples mix together gently pour into a lined and greased 20cm square or round cake tin smooth out top. Bake in 160deg oven 1 ½ hrs until cake springs back when lightly touched. Turn out onto covered wire rack.

## Honey Oat Bar Recipe

### Ingredients

- 1 Cup Rolled Oats
- 1 Cup Sultanas
- ½ Cup Self-Raising Flour (sifted)
- ½ Cup Raw Sugar
- ½ Cup Desiccated Coconut
- 155g Butter
- 2 tbls Honey

### Method

Combine dry ingredients into bowl

Melt Butter, add Honey, mix into dry ingredients until mixture clings together

Press evenly over base of well-greased 28cm x 18cm (11" x 7") Lamington pan

Bake in 190 C (375F) oven for 15-20 minutes or until golden brown.

Cut into bars approximately 5cm x 5cm while hot, remove from pan when cold

### **Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rich Fruit Cake Competition**

Delivery of Exhibits- 8am - 1030 Friday 14<sup>th</sup> October Free Entry

1st prize of \$25 and a ribbon donated by Agricultural Societies Council of NSW  
All entries MUST use the compulsory recipe below. The entry gaining 1st place is eligible to enter the group final. If successful at the group final, then invited to compete at RAS Sydney Royal Easter Show 2023.

## ASC RICH FRUIT CAKE - REGULATIONS

### 1. Competition Objective:

- a. The NSW Rich Fruit Cake Competition is conducted to seek excellence in the preparation, cooking and presentation of a rich fruit cake and to promote Australian produce.

### 2. Competition Process:

- a. The NSW Rich Fruit Cake Competition is conducted in three stages:
  - i. Local competitions conducted under these regulations, held at Agricultural Shows affiliated with the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW. Recommend Entry be free
    1. Winners receive the specified prize and are eligible to enter the second stage of the competition.
  - ii. Group Finals are conducted in each of the 14 regional groups of the ASC of NSW where at least two eligible entrants have won a local competition in the current year. Entry is only open to eligible winners of local competitions. Entry is free.
    1. Eligible entrants are required to bake a second Rich Fruit Cake to compete in the Group Final.
    2. Winners receive the specified prize and are eligible to enter the third or final stage of the competition.
    3. If there is only one eligible entrant in a group, they will be automatically appointed Group finalist without having to present a second cake and will proceed to the State Final.
  - iii. NSW State Final is to be held at the Sydney Royal Easter Show annually. Entry is open only to the Group finalists from regional competitions. Entry is free.
    1. Group Finalists are required to bake a third Rich Fruit Cake to compete in the NSW State Final.
    2. Winners receive the specified prize and are presented the ASC Plaque.

### 3. Rules

- a. Entry to the competition is free.
- b. At all stages of the competition Entrants must use the recipe provided.
- c. In any year an individual competitor may participate in only one Group Final representing one Agricultural Show and, consequently, may represent only one Group in the subsequent State Final.
- d. Agricultural Shows & ASC Groups of Shows conducting local competitions &/or Group Finals agree to follow these rules and guidelines.

## Section D

### **Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rich Fruit Cake Competition**

#### **Ingredients:**

250g (8oz) Sultanas	90g (3oz) Chopped Red Glacé Cherries
250g (8oz) Currants	90g (3oz) Chopped Blanched Almonds
250g (8oz) Plain Flour	1/3 Cup Sherry or Brandy
250g (8oz) Soft Brown Sugar	1/2 tsp Vanilla Essence
250g (8oz) Butter	1/4 tsp Nutmeg
125g (4oz) Chopped Mixed Peel	1/2 tsp Almond Essence
250g (8oz) Chopped Raisins	1/2 tsp Ground Ginger
60g (2oz) Self Raising Flour	1/2 tsp Lemon Essence or Finely Grated
1/2 tsp Ground Cloves	Lemon Rind
4 Large Eggs	

#### **Method:**

- Mix together all the fruits and nuts and sprinkle with brandy or sherry.
- Cover and leave for at least one (1) hour or preferably overnight.
- Sift together the flour and spices.
- Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences and add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition.
- Now Alternating add fruit and flour mixtures, mix thoroughly.
- The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon.
- Place the mixture into a prepared Square 20cm x 20 cm (8in) tin and bake in a slow oven for approximately 3 ½ - 4 hours.
- Allow the cake to cool in the tin.

Note: To ensure uniformity and depending upon size, it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2-3 pieces, cherries into 4-6 pieces, and almonds crosswise into 3-4 pieces.

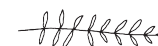
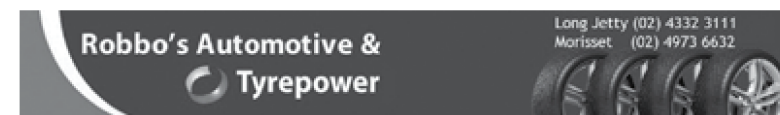

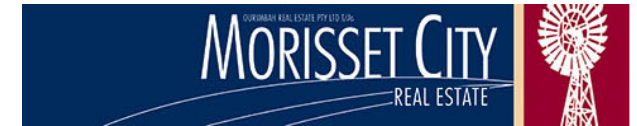
