Junior (12 Years and Under)

- 1028. Best Spring Flowering Pot - may be a mix of plants in one pot not exceeding 550mm. Some small embellishment allowed

- 1029. Best Potted Cactus
- 1030. Best Potted Succulent
- 1031. Best Mini Succulent and/or Cactus Garden 300mm or smaller
- 1032. Best Succulent and/or Cactus Garden 300mm to 550mm Diameter

- 1033. Best Bonsai up to 300mm Pot
