- Cattle to be ready for NLIS scanning at 8:30am on Saturday 21st October, with completed National Vendor Declaration Form/Travelling Stock statement/waybill
- This section will be run under the by-laws and regulations of the Association, such regulations and by laws are available for inspection at the Association's regulations.
- All cattle must be registered with their recognised Breed Societies
- National cattle health declaration to accompany all entries. This can be found on the Morisset Show website - <http://www.morissetshow.org.au/>
- All processed entries will be forward to the relevant breed society for verification.
- Further particulars regarding breed, age, pedigree, name of beast, class no. and exhibitors name or stud must be given on entry form.
- Properly broken in to lead and tie up. Committee has the right to eliminate an animal that does not comply with all Association's regulations.
- Beef Cattle must be haltered and all bulls over 12 months of age must have a nose ring fitted.
- A calf under 9 months of age may parade with its mother in the cow classes.
- Registration certificates are required at the inspection of Stud Cattle. Expiators are not to post or send registration certificates or copies.
- All cows or heifers 2 ½ years old and over must have had a calf eligible to be registered with the relevant Breed society, within the last 12 months, or be verified by a Veterinary Certificate.
- All exhibitors are required to complete the National Cattle Health Declaration. The National Cattle Health Declaration must be signed by the owner or the person responsible for the cattle.
- Exhibitors must provide certification that the animals entered for Competition in all cattle classes. Including calves at foot, have been tested for Pestivirus and certified as non-PI (persistently infected). Certification must be provided in the form of a laboratory report for signed veterinary Certificate, listing animals and their identification. Animals previously tested and certified as non-PI are not required to be tested, however certification must be provided

2027. Heifer under 12 months

2028. Heifer 12 months and under 16 months

2029. Heifer 16 months and under 20 months
