- Rules and Conditions**
1. Classes may be combined or divided at the Judge/Chief Steward's discretion
 2. All goats must be free of all contagious or infectious diseases and show no obvious signs of internal and external parasites and be presented clean and in show condition.
 3. All Goats must be registered with the DGSA and entered into their respective eligible classes
 4. All goats will be judged under DGSA Inc and MLMAA Inc rules and regulations.
 5. Age will be as of date of the show.
 6. Stud signage is only permitted after the commencement of judging.
 7. All exhibitors must submit their PIC Property No. With their entries.
 8. All exhibitors must submit their Transport Stock Statement No. on arrival at the Show

2110. Type and Production – doe must have completed an official 24 hour milk test anywhere in Australia in the past 2 years. Points and test date to be stated on the entry form and the test results to be available at the show.
2111. Doe, any dairy breed, with best udder, 1st lactation. To be judged in milk and milked out.
2112. Doe, any dairy breed, with best udder, 2nd and subsequent lactation. To be judged in milk and milked out.
