All entries will be displayed at Morisset Show All entries must be prepared within last 12 months. Entries must be delivered to Morisset Show Ground at the following times: Tuesday 14th OCTOBER 10 am - 2 pm or Wednesday 15th OCTOBER 5 pm - 7 pm Please note that the Judge's decision will be final. All honey must be exhibited in a 500gram CLEAN, CLEAR GLASS jar with a WHITE LID.

Classes:

- 1601. Liquid Honey - Light
 - 1602. Liquid Honey - Medium
 - 1603. Liquid Honey - Dark.
 - 1604. Candied Honey.
 - 1605. Creamed Honey.
 - 1606. Flowhive Any Colour.
 - 1607. Beeswax: Rendered for Display. Must be a block not less than 500 grams & not more than 1 kg. No fancy shapes or patterns. Only Square, Round or Rectangle will be accepted.
 - 1608. Natural Beeswax Moulds x 3:
 - 1609. Candles: Dipped, moulded or rolled All Candles will be burnt for 1 hour.
 - 1610. Comb Honey, A Frame of any size, including Warre or Top Bar, No sealed brood, no pollen, no dripping honey, no decorative edging, no plastic foundation. Must be in a suitable SEALED display case.
 - 1611. Native Bee Honey in Jar provided.
- Children's Section - Please include Name, Age and School
- 1612. A Rolled Candle.
 - 1613. A round Natural Beeswax decorative candle.
 - 1614. Draw a bee - Judged by art section coordinator.
